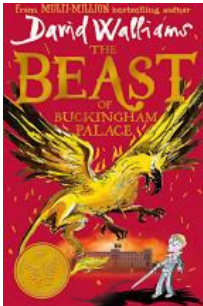


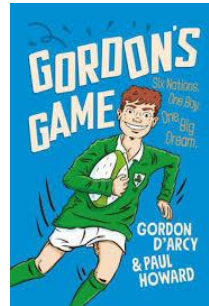

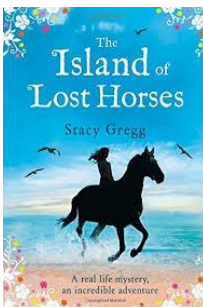
The Beast of Buckingham Palace by David Walliams - €13.99

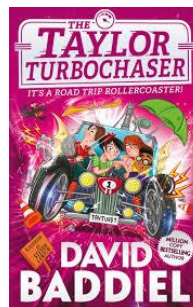
Gordon's Game by Gordon D'Arcy & Paul Howard - €12.99

The Island of Lost Horses by Stacy Gregg - €10.70

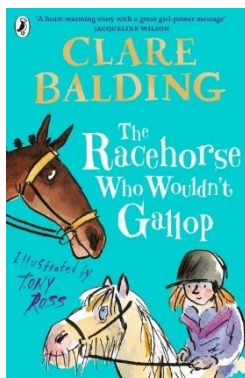

The Taylor Turbochaser by David Baddiel - €12.50

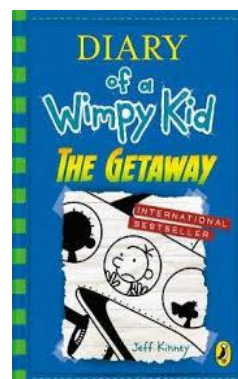
Amy Taylor loves cars. Here are her favourite ones:

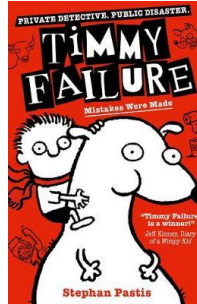
Diary of a Wimpy Kid: The Getaway by Jeff Kinney - €9.60

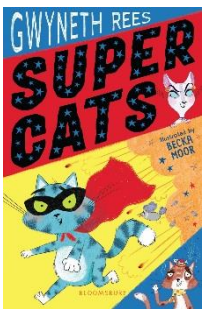
Alice Next Door by Judi Curtin - €8.99

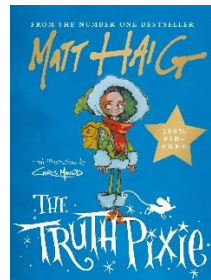
Timmy Failure: Mistakes Were Made by Stephan Pastis - €9.60

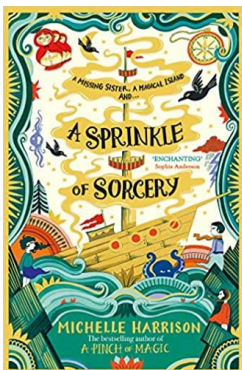
Super Cats by Gwyneth Rees - €8.20
