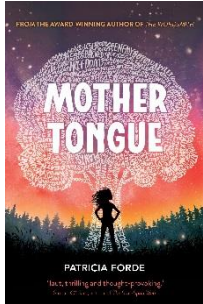


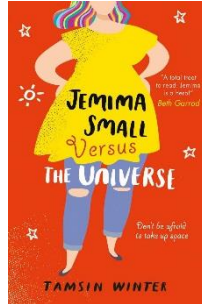


Recommended Reading List – Teenage



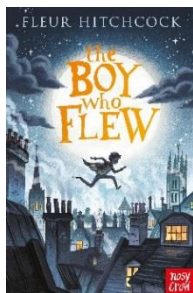
Mother Tongue by Patricia Forde - €8.99

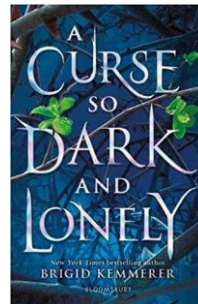
Jemima Small Versus the Universe by Tamsin Winter - €10.95

The Boy Who Flew by Fleur Hitchcock - €9.60

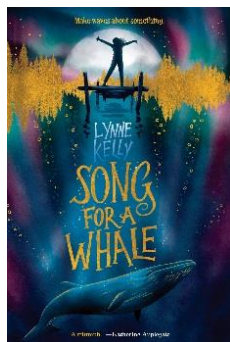

A Curse So Dark And Lonely by Brigid Kemmerer - €10.95

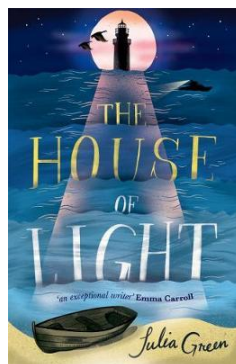

Harper's life has never been easy, but she's learned to be tough enough to survive the streets of Washington, DC. When she is sucked into Rhen's world, nothing is as it seems.



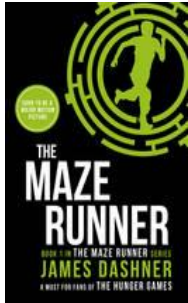
Song for A Whale by Lynne Kelly €9.45

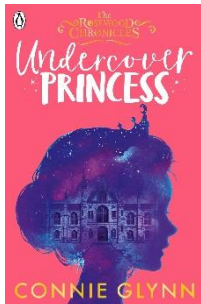
The Maze Runner by James Dashner - €10.95

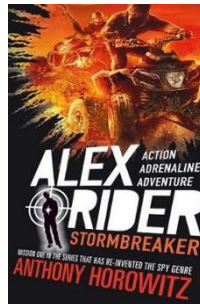
Five Feet Apart by Rachael Lippincott €10.95

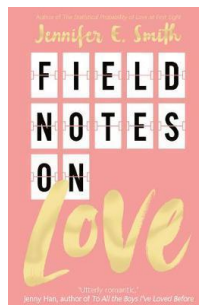
Stormbreaker (Alex Rider) by Anthony Horowitz - €9.99
