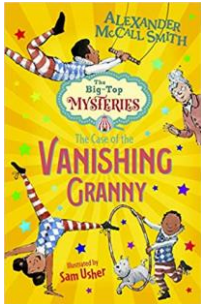


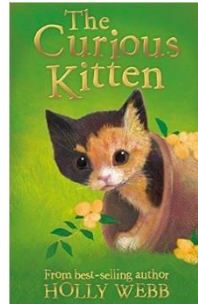

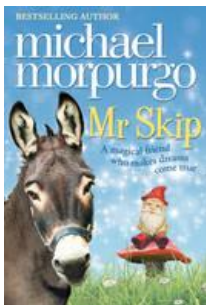
The Case of the Vanishing Granny by Alexander McCall Smith - €9.60

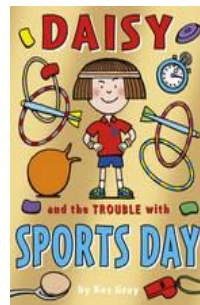
The Curious Kitten by Holly Webb - €6.35

Mr Skip by Michael Morpurgo - €8.20

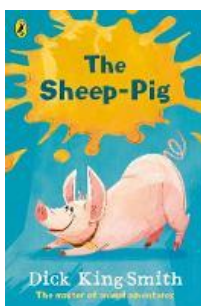

The 13 -Storey Treehouse By Andy Griffiths €9.15

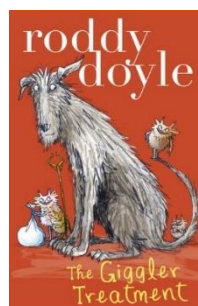
