With effect from the 11<sup>th</sup> December 2023, the Board of Management of Ennis National School has determined that the maximum mainstream class size will be 26 pupils for any classes that currently have less than this maximum capacity (Board of Management meeting of 11<sup>th</sup> December 2023). Classes that have 26 or more pupils are deemed to be full and there are no places available in those classes.
