



Traffic Tips

Ennis National School is accessed via a Public Road. Below are Tips devised to help minimise delays. Remember, the car park is for use by Preschool, Junior and Senior Infants, 1st and 2nd class children (and their siblings) only. Thank you!

- 1 **Drop your children to the  Walking Bus  in the morning.** It leaves **Éire Óg Car Parkat 8:30am sharp.**
- 2 **Drop and Go.** 1st-6th Classes drop and go. Infant Class parents are invited to walk their children as far as the infant yard gate.
- 3 Avoid the school by dropping away from the school. Footpaths are provided for safe access.
- 4 **PLEASE NEVER, EVER.....park or pull over** in the **Red Zones** on the map. Doing so prevents the free flow of traffic and could obstruct emergency vehicles.
- 5 **Park** in one of the allocated parking spaces **OR Pull Over** to the **LEFT** when dropping and **RIGHT** when collecting.
- 6 Prepare your children for drop off. Let them in and out of the car on the path side and not on the traffic side of the car.
- 7 **Keep moving.** Cars moving out of parking spaces will be free to exit when cars are stopped at pedestrian crossing.
- 8 **PLEASE NEVER, EVER.....**let your children out of or into the car when you're in the flow of traffic!
- 9 The staff car park can only be used **when a child is unable to walk** due to injury or otherwise. Passes for staff car park are available from the school.
- 10 **Please cooperate with all Volunteers** (in hi vis/vests) who help to keep traffic flowing

The car park is particularly busy in the first months of the school year; patience is a virtue. Check out our Traffic Tips information and follow the directions of the volunteer crossing guard.

If you plan to walk to the gate with your child, please reverse park into a spot.

If you plan to drop and go, please pull in to the left behind other parked cars and have your child exit on the left side of the vehicle directly to the footpath. Drive into the car park as far as you can go before pulling over to leave room for drivers behind you to fit in.
